About the Project

Canford School is a renowned independent co-educational boarding school located in Wimborne, Dorset. Established in 1923, the school has a rich history that is reflected in its stunning buildings and facilities.

The main school building, known as the Manor, dates back to the 19th century and is a Grade I listed building. It was designed by the renowned architect Sir Charles Barry, who also designed the Houses of Parliament in London.

The Manor has been meticulously restored and refurbished over the years, and today it houses the school's administration offices, classrooms, and common rooms, which we have recently completed the refurbishment of
